

Emergency Procedures

Procedures in the event of First Aid

- Call for assistance
- Ring 999 or 112
- Explain accident and injury to child
- The person speaking to you will ask:-
 - Are they conscious?
 - Can they breathe?
 - Can they talk to you?
 - Patients name and date of birth.
- The person speaking to you will then make an assessment and then either:
 - Send an ambulance immediately

If it is not life threatening, either an ambulance or a first aid responder will be there within 60 minutes.

For the patient:-

- Reassure them they are okay
- Nil by mouth
- Keep still, do not move them, cover with blanket.

If their condition worsens ring 999 or 112 back.

Contact parents at some point during the above procedure.

If a child needs to go to hospital then always contact 999 or 112 for advice.

If transport by staff car then gain consent from parent/carer first – 2 witnesses to consent given and recorded.
