


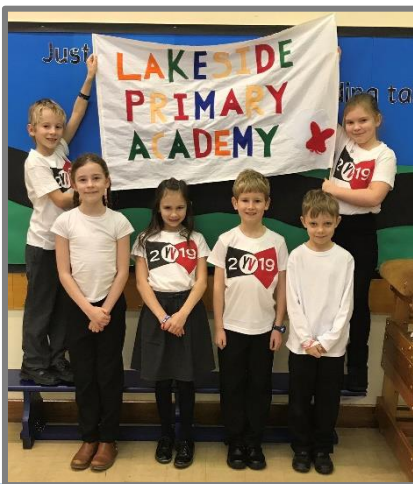
A message from the Head of School...

I hope you have had a good start to the year I know we certainly have. Walking around school the children are calm and really engaged in their learning. Here are a few highlights of the week

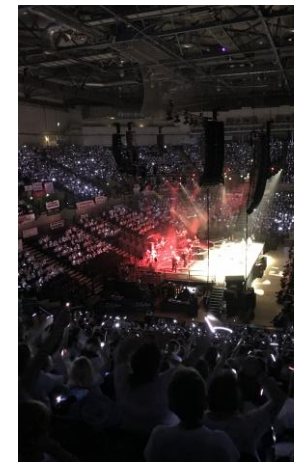
