We will continue to send home weekly spellings for a test on a particular spelling rule as well as the Year 3/4 keywords the children need to know by the end of Year 4.

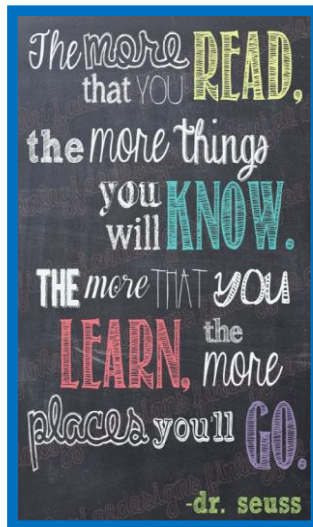
It is important that children practise these regularly at home.

See the 'Leeds Mummy' Nesyamun at Leeds City Museum.

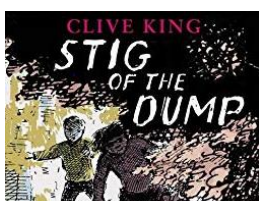
Entrance is free.
