*Each class has been working on a different wordless book and really developing their comprehension through **inference** and **deduction**.*

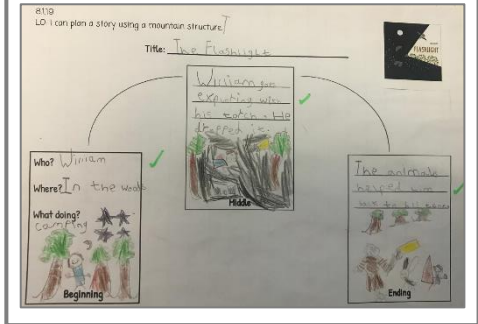
Inference: is an interpretation that goes beyond the literal information given.

A book does not need to have words to help us develop these skills as the saying goes ...

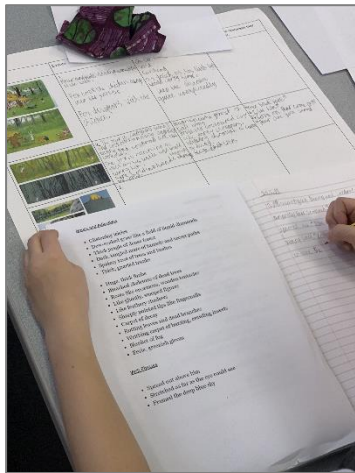
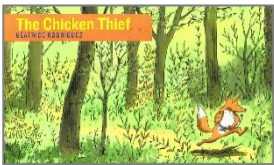
