We are seeking your permission to provide and manage a G Suite for Education account for your child. This is a set of education productivity tools from Google including Gmail, Calendar, Docs, Classroom, and more used by tens of millions of students and teachers around the world. At Ebor Academy Trust, students will use their G Suite accounts to complete assignments, communicate with their teachers, sign into their Chromebooks, and learn 21st century digital citizenship skills.

If you don't provide your consent, we will not create a G Suite for Education account for your child. If consent is not given your child will not be able to use their Google account at school or home.

If consent has been given and you no longer wish your child to take part in G Suite for Education, please let us know. We will remove all information within one week of receiving written notice. Your child's G Suite for Education account will be terminated within one month of leaving the school.
