Parable	a simple story used to illustrate a moral or spiritual lesson	What was Jesus' 'mission statement'?	"The Spirit of the Lord is on me, because he has anointed me to proclaim good news to the poor. He has sent me to proclaim freedom for the prisoners and recovery of sight for the blind, to set the oppressed free, to proclaim the year of the Lord's favour." It had 5 points -to give poor people good news, to free prisoners, to help the blind to see, to give liberty to oppressed people and to tell people God would bless them.
Mission statement	a formal summary of the aims and values of a company, organization, or individual.	The value of love	Christians believe that the love of God is the greatest treasure; that giving your life for others is the greatest love, and that in the end, love wins and even death will be destroyed.
Oppressed	subject to harsh treatment.	What do Jesus' parables about forgiveness teach to Christians today?	Jesus teaches that we all need forgiveness, but those of us who need it most may be the most grateful. Jesus teaches that a thankful response to God's generous forgiveness is to forgive others who do wrong to us. Crucifixion- Romans used this torturing punishment as a way of killing their enemies, and it was designed to terrify all who saw it.
Crucifixion	an ancient form of execution in which a person was nailed or bound to a cross.	How do Christians today try to follow Jesus' teaching about justice and fairness?	Mother Teresa - love, the duty to serve, the idea that serving the poor is a privilege. She believed in practising justice not just speaking about it.
Privilege	a special right, advantage, or immunity granted or available only to a particular person or group.	What did Jesus teach about being generous and being greedy?	Generosity: it is not just about money, but also time, love, kindness, 'thank you' and compliments.
