Key question:

Celebration:

Create a class museum with facts about the artefacts and invite Mrs Hayes-Smith

Key Vocabulary: collage, fabric, glue, experiment, media, picture, texture, tear, private, personal information, construction, rigid, England, Australia, aeroplane, aviator, distance

Areas of Learning: English, RE, PSHE, History, Geography, DT, science

Prior Learning: Listen attentively and respond to what they hear with relevant questions, comments and actions when being read to and during whole class discussions and small group interactions;
