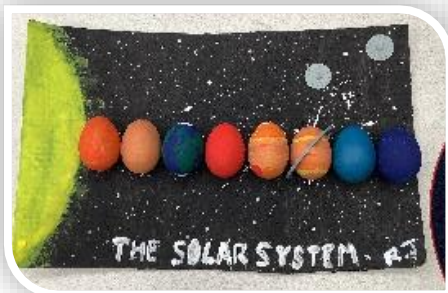

"I really liked all the dance but I felt tired afterwards!"

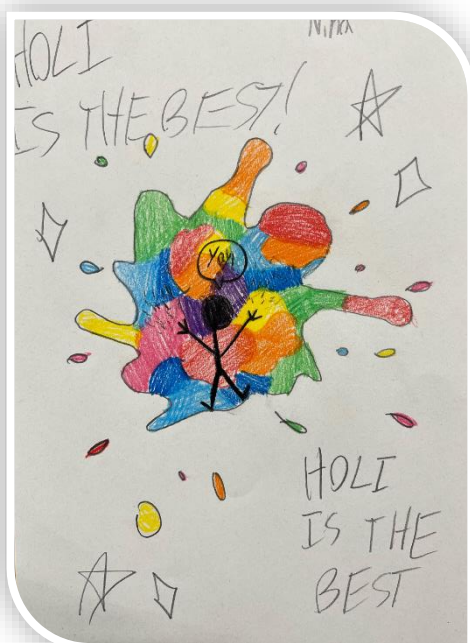

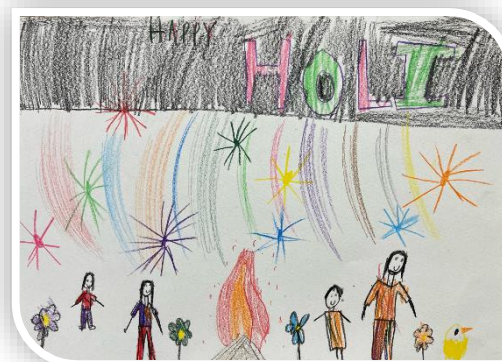
