Diversity Role Models



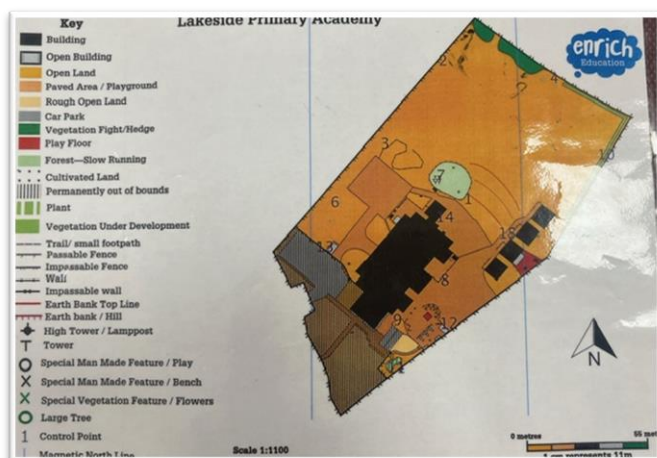
