the tip of the iceberg

The behaviours we see in young people are a little like the tip of an iceberg. These are the things we can see above the surface. However, it's important to consider what is lying below the surface in order to better understand how we can support and help.

Visible Behaviors (Above Water): cry, isolate self from others, lash out, run away, avoid/refuse, shout, harm others, threaten others, self harm, hide.

Underlying Causes (Below Water): anxiety, unloved, panic, poor friendships, neglect, fight or flight response, poor attachment, home life, low mood/sadness, grief, low self-esteem, abuse, confusion, poor relationships, unmet basic needs, traumatic experiences, cognitive functioning, bullying, learning difficulties, worried.

Consider what other behaviours you might see in young people and what other things might be below the surface which drive those behaviours.
